The MSc Management programme is designed to suit graduates in any discipline and those already in work who are looking to progress to a managerial position.

Flexible learning

Our MSc Management programme allows you to study at a pace and in a way that suits you.

- > three starts a year – January, May and September
- > choice from a range of class times
- > option to adjust the intensity of your study through our ‘mode neutral’ programme design, meaning you can choose to study anything from traditional one-year full-time programme through to a part-time programme spread up to a maximum of five years

How is the programme taught?

The programme will be taught using a combination of small group sessions, personal tutor support and live lectures, with an emphasis on practical skills. Our classes will prepare you for the realities of working in a management role.

You will benefit from one small group session for every lecture. As an example, a 15 credit module would involve 90 minutes of lectures and 90 minutes in a small group session per week.

In addition, you will have the opportunity to access recordings of live lectures via the Business School’s Virtual Learning Environment which is accessible online. This popular resource will allow you to revisit past lectures at your convenience from the workplace or home.

Programme content

To achieve a full MSc you are required to complete twelve modules on disciplines fundamental to a career in management.

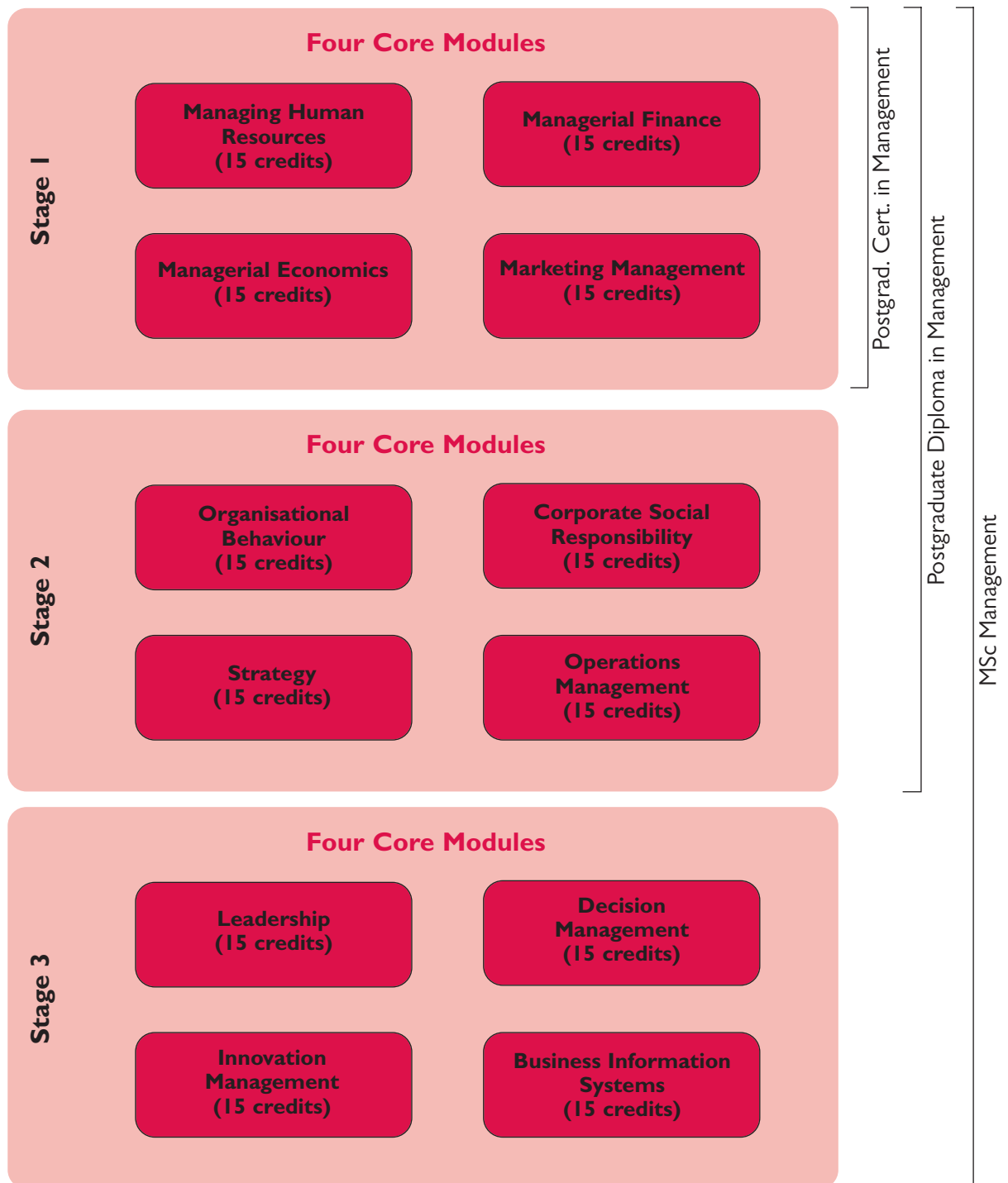
If you only wish to complete the programme up to the end of stage 1 or stage 2, you can still qualify with a Postgraduate Certificate or Postgraduate Diploma in Management.

Studying the complete MSc full-time, all modules/stages are covered in one year. Alternatively our 'mode neutral' study allows you to spread the modules/stages over any other period from a minimum of fifteen months to a maximum of five years.

In addition, our highly flexible programme design allows you to re-enter the programme at one of our three entry points a year, should you choose to upgrade your Postgraduate Certificate or Diploma to a full MSc.

Assessment

The programme is assessed on a module-by-module basis using a combination of course work and closed-book examinations.

We will give you continual feedback on your work throughout the programme to help you achieve success and maximise your potential.

Fees

Fees for the programme commencing in May 2009 are:

Full time: £11,750*

*The fee of £11,750 is based on studying a one-year full-time programme. The programme is 'mode neutral' and permits you to accelerate or decelerate your learning according to the number of modules you wish to undertake. For both full-time and 'mode neutral' study, you are able to pay through a series of manageable instalments.

These fees could be subject to change for our September intake.

Admissions requirements

To be eligible for entry onto the MSc Management programme you must have one of the following:

- > an undergraduate degree (minimum of a lower second class honours degree from a UK or recognised overseas institution), or
- > an equivalent accredited qualification, or
- > suitable work experience

Our aim is to recruit students with varied academic and professional backgrounds, therefore we encourage anyone with an appropriate qualification, Accredited Prior Learning or suitable work experience to apply.
